DATA MANAGEMENT STATEMENT

This document provides for the processing of your personal data and the rights of your personal data in accordance with the European Union Regulation (European Parliament and Council General Privacy Policy 2016/679, hereafter referred to as "GDPR") and national law (2011 Law on Information Self-Destruction and Freedom of Information) Act CXII of 2007, hereinafter "Info").

1. OBJECTIVE OF THE REGULATION

The purpose of this Policy is to record the data protection and data management data used by KOVÁCSNÉ ONDRISEK MELINDA, 58424906 (Hereinafter: Service Provider, headquarters: 1121 Budapest János Zsigmond utca 12/B TAX number: 46911249-1-43) principles and the Service Provider's data protection and data management policy.

The Service Provider manages the data of the visitors to the Website, the web page registrars and the customers (collectively, the "Affected") of the website www.bbisuniform.hu (hereinafter referred to as "the Website").

The purpose of this Policy is to ensure that all services provided by the Provider are secured to all individuals to respect their rights, in particular their privacy, in the processing of their personal data (data protection).

3. RANGE OF HANDED PERSONAL DATA

3.1. Data management related to registration

During registration, you must provide the following personal information: name, e-mail address, password, billing address (billing name, street name, house number, town, postal code), delivery address (delivery name, street name, house number, postal code), telephone number.

3.2. Technical details

Technically recorded data during the operation of the system: the data of the affected Login computer generated during the use of the service and recorded by the Service Provider as an automatic result of the technical processes. The data that will be automatically recorded will be automatically logged on entry or exit, without the specific statement or action of the Person. These data can not be linked to other personal user information, except in cases that are legally binding.

3.3. cookie

Visits to the Website will send one or more cookies - a small file containing a string of characters - to the visitor's computer, which will allow its browser to be uniquely identified. These cookies are provided by Google and are used through Google Adwords. These cookies will only be sent to the visitor's computer by visiting some sub-pages, so in this case only the actual time and the time of visiting that sub-page will be stored, no other information.

Cookies Applied:

- Session Cookie: session cookies will be automatically deleted after visiting the Affected Person. These cookies are designed to make the Service Provider's Web site more efficient and secure, so it is essential that some features of the Web site or some applications work properly.

- Persistent cookies: a permanent cookie is also used by the Service Provider for a better user experience (eg providing optimized navigation). These cookies are stored for longer in the browser cookie file. The duration depends on the setting applied by your affected web browser.

- Password-protected session cookie.

- Shopping Cart Required.

- Security cookie.

External servers help you independently measure and audit Web site visitor and other webanalytic data (Google Analytics). Data controllers can provide detailed information about the handling of measurement data to the affected party. They can be reached at www.google.com/analytics

If you do not want Google Analytics to measure the above data for the purpose and purpose described, install the blocking plugin in your browser.

The "Help" feature in most of the browser's menubar provides you with information about your browser

- how to disable cookies,

- how to accept new cookies or

- how to instruct your browser to set a new cookie or

- how to turn off other cookies.

4. THE LEGAL BASIS, OBJECTIVE AND MODE OF DATA MANAGEMENT

4.1. Data management is based on the Relevant Volunteer Declaration based on the Website, which contains the express consent of the Affected Person to use the personal information provided during the use of the Website. The legal basis for data management is the CXII 2011 Law on Information Self-Destruction and Freedom of Information. TV. (Infotv.) Section 5 (1) (a), on the basis of the voluntary contribution of the person concerned, and in accordance with Section CVIII of 2001 on certain aspects of electronic commerce services and information society services; law.

Your consent to the use of the Site by registering, or voluntarily providing the information in question, is affected by each Affiliation.

4.2. The purpose of data management is to ensure the provision of services available on the Website. The Service Provider shall provide the data provided by the Affected subject only to the execution of the order, to the delivery of the house, to allow invoicing, to maintain contact

4.3. The data that are automatically recorded will be used for statistics generation, technical development of the IT system, and protection of the rights of the interested parties.

4.4. The Service Provider shall not use or use the personal data provided for purposes other than those set out in these points. Issuance of personal data to a third party or authorities may, unless expressly provided for by law, be subject to prior consent by the Participant.

4.5. The Service Provider does not control any Personal Information you have entered. The correctness of the data given is solely the responsibility of the person giving it. When you contact any of your Affected Email addresses, you are responsible for solely using the provided e-mail address. With respect to this responsibility, any liability associated with an entry in a given e-mail address shall be borne exclusively by the person who has registered the e-mail address.

5. DURATION OF DATA MANAGEMENT

5.1. The handling of personal data provided during registration begins with registration and will be canceled upon request. In the case of non-mandatory data, data processing will last from the date of the data entry to the deletion of the data in question. The cancellation of the registration and the cancellation by the Service Provider at any time in the General Terms and Conditions (hereinafter referred to as the General Terms and Conditions) may be recorded in the case and in the manner specified.

5.2. The Service Provider fulfills the obligation of retention prescribed by law (eg in accounting law) regarding data related to orders placed on the Website.

6. DIRECTIONS OF PERSONS WITH DATA, ADAPTATION, DATA PROCESSING

6.1. Data is primarily the Service Provider's and Service Provider's internal staff, but they are not disclosed to third parties.

6.2. The operation of the IT system, the fulfillment of orders, and the settlement of the settlement process, the Service Provider uses data processors (eg administrator, carrier company).

7. CONCERNED RIGHTS AND LEGAL POSSIBILITIES

7.1. You may at any time have the right to request information about the personal data that you treat and handle on the Service Provider and may change them at any time in the manner specified in the GTC.

7.2. The Service Provider shall, on the Request of the Person concerned, provide information about the data it manages, the data processed by the data processor entrusted by him or by the data processor, the source, the purpose, legal basis, duration of the data processing, the effects of the incident, its effects and the measures taken to remedy it, and, in the case of transmission of the personal data of the Person concerned, the legal basis and the addressee of the transfer. The Service Provider shall provide the requested information in writing within 30 days of the submission of the application.

7.4. You may at any time have the right to correct or erase incorrectly recorded data. Some of your information may be corrected by the Affected Website; In other cases, the Service Provider will cancel the data within 3 working days of receiving the request, in which case they will not be recovered. The deletion does not apply to data processing required by law (eg accounting rules), which the Service Provider maintains for the required period of time.

7.5. You can also ask your Person to block your data. The Service Provider locks out personal data when requested by the data subject or if, based on the information available to it, it is assumed that the deletion would violate the legitimate interests of the Affected Person. Personal data so locked can only be handled as long as there is a data management target that excludes the deletion of personal data.

The person concerned must be notified of the correction, blocking and deletion, and all who have previously been transferred to the data for data handling. Notification may be omitted if it does not prejudice the legitimate interest of the Person concerned in view of the purpose of the processing.

If the Service Provider fails to comply with the Relevant Correction, Lockout or Cancellation Policy, it will give written and factual reasons for refusal of the request for rectification, blocking or cancellation within 30 days of receipt of the request.

You may object to handling your personal information. The Service Provider shall examine the protest within the shortest possible time but not later than 15 days from the submission of the request, and shall make a decision on its validity and shall inform the applicant in writing.

7.6. The Affected Info. (1125 Budapest, Szilágyi Erzsébet fasor 22 / c, www.naih.hu), and in accordance with the Civil Code (Act V of 2013), may exercise its rights before the Court of Justice.

7.7. If you have provided third-party information during the registration or you have caused any damage to your use of the Website during the registration, the Service Provider is entitled to claim damages against the Affiliation. In such a case, the Service Provider shall provide all available assistance to the determining authorities for the purpose of establishing the identity of the infringing person.

8. E-MAIL ADDRESSES

The Service Provider shall pay particular attention to the legality of the use of the e-mail addresses it manages, so use it only as specified below (for information or advertisement) to send an e-mail.

8.1. Managing e-mail addresses primarily serves to identify the Customer, to execute orders, to access the Services, so that e-mails are sent primarily for this purpose.

8.2. In some cases, the Service Provider will provide information about the changes and other similar services of the Service Provider in the electronic form by e-mail to the Affiliates, in the case of the services provided by the Service Provider or the GCSE. Such notifications, however, are not used by the Service Provider for advertising purposes.

9. OTHER PROVISIONS

9.1. The Service Provider may collect data about the Activity of the Affiliates that can not be linked to the other data provided by the Affiliate upon registration or any other data generated by the use of other websites or services.

9.2. In all cases where the Service Provider intends to use the provided data for purposes other than the purpose of the original data collection, he or she shall inform the Affected Person by means of which he or she shall obtain a prior express consent or provide him with an opportunity to prohibit the use.

9.3. The Service Provider undertakes to ensure the security of the data and also to take technical measures to ensure that the data that are recorded, stored or managed is protected and that it does everything in its power to prevent their destruction, unauthorized use and unauthorized alteration. You also agree that any third party to which the data may be transmitted or handed over also calls for compliance with this obligation.

9.4. The Service Provider reserves the right to unilaterally modify these Terms and Conditions without prior notice to the Website of the Affected. Upon the entry into force of the amendment, the User shall accept the changes to continue using the Website, as provided by the Provider in the manner provided on the Website.
